Ksenia Kozolova is from Russia and Montverde Academy added her to girls' varsity basketball roster.




Jaden Narwal


Yelizaveta Sharkova


Dusan Keca

Henrik Hofman and Dino Hofman are basketball players from Croatia. They went to Liberty Christian Prep in Tavares, FL




Milena Kovacevic

Egon Ruhek – First Love Academy


Born in 1999, played for all youth national teams of Croatia. He got a full scholarship for First Love Academy.

A member of U16 and U17 Turkish national teams. He got an offer from one of the best schools in the USA regarding both academics and sports – Montverde academy




Scherine Dahoue

Plays as a center and is a member of Croatian youth national team. She chose Fordham University which competes in NCAA division 1.




Luka Tabak
